Curriculum Vitae

Masayuki Kawai was born in 1972, Osaka and lives in Tokyo. He creates video works in a unique style that offers radical visions of philosophy and politics derived from his consideration and criticism of informational society and the essence of media. His exploratory techniques and activities are unconstrained by genres such as film, contemporary art, and media art. His works have been shown in over 30 countries and have received numerous awards in festivals and exhibitions, including Oberhausen Short Film Festival and Young Video Artists Initiative at Mori Art Museum in Tokyo. They are collected by Queens Museum of Art in New York (USA) and National Museum of Art in Osaka and 21st Century Museum of Contemporary Art, Kanazawa (Japan).

To establish a critical roll for video art in the society of spectacle, Kawai as video artist, organizer, curator and writer, founded an organization for video art, Videoart Center Tokyo in 2001 and was its director till 2004. He also worked as an art director in Phaidros cafe, an innovative video art cafe in Shibuya, Tokyo from 2001 to 2004. He has contributed to many projects of video art like curating programs, organizing festivals, publishing magazines world-wide. He writes critical discourses as an author in many books and magazines and published the first theoretical monograph in Japan on video art titled *Reflexion: The Practical Aesthetics of Video Art*.

Kawai was invited artist in residence at the Jerusalem Center for Visual Arts, ISCP (USA), and at Le Cube and Cité internationale des arts in Paris, with support from the Jerusalem Foundation, Agency for Cultural Affairs for Japanese Government, POLA Art Foundation, Tokyo Wonder Site, City Government of Paris and Culturesfrance.

He worked as a member of the jury for 58th Oberhausen International Short Film Festival in 2012.

In 2011 and 2012, he served himself as one the founder and program director of "Hors Pistes Tokyo", cutting-edge annual moving image art festival co-organized by Pompidou Centre. In 2016 he takes office as the general director.

Masayuki Kawai as video artist is represented by MORI YU GALLERY, Kyoto and Chi-Wen Gallery, Taipei.
